Ms. Elaine (Daisy) Bradley assumed the position of Corporate Audit Director, Lockheed Martin-BAE Corporate Audit Directorate (LM-BAE), Defense Contract Audit Agency (DCAA), in October 2024. Ms. Bradley is an advisor to the Director and is responsible for strategic management and operations of the CAD and its resources. She leads approximately 350 employees in providing mission-critical contract audit and financial advisory services to the Department of Defense, other Executive Departments, and foreign governments. She oversees and manages an annual operating budget of approximately \$50 million.

Ms. Bradley previously served as the Deputy Regional Director, Eastern Region, DCAA, from June 2023 to September 2024. Ms. Bradley came to DCAA from the Air Force Audit Agency, where she served as the Associate Director for the Acquisition Division of the Acquisition, Logistics, and Financial Audits Directorate, Air Force Audit Agency, Wright-Patterson AFB, Ohio. She oversaw Department of the Air Force and major command level audits for the \$84 billion Air and Space acquisition portfolios along with three smaller portfolios. Specifically, she was responsible for the planning, execution, and reporting of Air- and Space Force-wide audits addressing major and non-major weapon system acquisition; research, development, test, and evaluation activities; science and technology programs; small business advocacy and compliance; and contracting functions.

Ms. Bradley also served as the Air Force Audit Agency Air and Space Operations Division Program Manager where she developed a form of “just in time” audits to provide Air Force leaders timely feedback on strategic program initiative implementation success. She led the completion of 62 audits in 1 year, reviewing all 55 of the Air Force’s strategic initiatives, leading to improved governance, resource identification, plan development, and execution of key initiatives.

Ms. Bradley began her government career in the United States Army as a logistics specialist and paratrooper at Ft. Liberty (formerly Ft. Bragg), North Carolina. After leaving active duty, she worked as a Staff Accountant in a public accounting firm. She began her civil service career as an installation level Auditor in 2003. Since that time, she held positions of increasing responsibility at various world-wide locations, including Audit Manager, Team Chief, Chief of Staff, Program Manager, and Associate Director.

Ms. Bradley holds a Masters of Business Administration from the University of Phoenix and a Bachelor of Business Administration in Accounting from Campbell University, North Carolina. Her certifications include the DoD Financial Management Certification - Level III, Certified Defense Financial Manager, and she is a Certified Internal Auditor. Ms. Bradley has been recognized with the Army Meritorious Service Medal, Armed Forces Civilian Service Medal, the Army Commendation Medal, the Secretary of Defense Medal for Global War on Terrorism – Civilian, and the Humanitarian Service Medal. She has received numerous other awards and recognition of excellence in performance throughout her distinguished career with the Department of Defense.
