





FREDRICK E. CARR ASSISTANT DIRECTOR OPERATIONS



Mr. Fredrick E. Carr assumed the position of Assistant Director, Operations, Defense Contract Audit Agency (DCAA) in April 2023. He strategically leads a workforce of 150 personnel who provide management information system and data analytics support, investigative support services, financial liaison advisory services, and quantitative methods policy to over 4000 auditors and support personnel dispersed throughout 300 offices worldwide. He oversees and manages an annual operating budget of approximately \$30 million.

Prior to coming to DCAA, Mr. Carr was the Deputy Assistant Secretary for Financial Operations, Office of the Assistant Secretary for Financial Management and Comptroller, Arlington, Virginia. Mr. Carr served as the principal adviser to the Assistant Secretary and the Air Force senior staff on all issues involving the amended Chief Financial Officers Act of 1990 and related financial management reforms. He was responsible at the executive level for ensuring the Air Force complies with legislative and executive financial management mandates leading to the effective and efficient use of the Air Force resources. Additional responsibilities included the management of human resources and technology solutions for Air Force financial management.

Mr. Carr was appointed to the Senior Executive Service in July 2016. He began his military career in 1981, serving two years in the Air National Guard and four years in the active Air Force. He transitioned into the civilian federal workforce via the Air Force Palace Acquire program in 1990. Mr. Carr served as the Director of Financial Reporting and Compliance where his responsibilities included Air Force financial statements, accounting policy and standards, compliance with statutory and regulatory requirements and principle support to the improvement of financial information for audit readiness.

Mr. Carr holds a Masters of Business Administration from Syracuse University in Syracuse, New York and a Bachelor of Science in Accounting from Wright State University, Dayton, Ohio. He is a graduate of the Army Comptrollership Program and the Air War College. He is a licensed Certified Public Account, holds a Level III certifications in the DoD Financial Management Certification and is a Certified Defense Manager (Acquisition). He received the Air Force Major Command Award for Technical Excellence, the DoD (Comptroller) Award for Innovative Technology in Financial Management, the Leonard F. Keenan Award for Distinguished Civilian Service and has received numerous awards and recognition of excellence in performance throughout his distinguished career with the Department of Defense.
