Mr. Willaim (Bill) H. Hunter assumed the position of Deputy Sea Director, Corporate Audits, Defense Contract Audit Agency (DCAA) in March 2026. Mr. Hunter serves as the principal advisor to the Sea Director and is responsible for strategic management and operations of the Sea Directorate and its resources pertaining to Defense contractor audits. He leads the organization in execution of the Sea Directorate's mission in providing contract audit and financial advisory services to the Department of War, Executive Departments and foreign governments. He is charged with managing and controlling expenditures of approximately \$150 million in annual operating funds.

In May 2024, Mr. Hunter was selected as the Chief Financial Officer (CFO) for DCAA. As the CFO, he was responsible for aligning the agency's \$638 million budget with its strategic vision and overseeing the professional development of more than 30 financial professionals. He managed the agency's financial operations, prepared financial statements, developed robust internal controls, and ensured the integrity and accountability of financial data in compliance with federal laws and regulations. Mr. Hunter has broad experience in the DoW, serving 35 years in the United States Air Force which he retired as a Colonel. After his military service, he founded Hunter Business Solutions LLC. In this position, he leveraged his extensive defense expertise to consult on a pivotal defense industrial base case study in Southern Mississippi, developing a strategic framework for the state to identify industrial gaps and target potential investments.

Mr. Hunter's military career began in 1987 when he enlisted directly out of high school, later receiving his commission in 1997 through the Air Force Reserve Officer Training Corps. Throughout his service, he demonstrated exceptional leadership in high-stakes environments, holding command positions at the Squadron, Group, and Wing levels, including as Commander of the 81st Training Wing at Keesler Air Force Base, where he led 12,000 personnel. He completed two tours in the Pentagon, first as the Operations & Maintenance Portfolio Manager and later as the Senior Military Assistant to the Office of the Secretary of Defense Comptroller. A combat veteran, he deployed to Afghanistan in 2006 and 2014.

Mr. Hunter holds two Masters of Business Administration from Nova Southern University, FL, and the Naval Postgraduate School, Monterey, CA and a Master of Science in National Resource Strategy from Eisenhower School at Ft McNair, DC. Additionally, he holds a Bachelor in Accountancy from University of Washington. He is a graduate of the Air War College, the Air Command and Staff College, and the Squadron Officer School at Maxwell AFB, AL. His certifications include Certified Level III in Defense Acquisition Workforce Improvement Act and a Certified Defense Financial Manager with Acquisition Specialty. Mr. Hunter has been married to his wife, Blanca, for 27 years, and they have five children.
