Ms. Angela L. Moomand assumed the position of Corporate Audit Director, Lockheed Martin and BAE in November 2019. Ms. Moomand is responsible for the strategic management and operations of DCAA's resources across all Lockheed Martin and BAE contractor sites. She leads over 350 employees in the execution of the Agency's mission - providing contract audit, accounting, and financial advisory services to the Department of Defense, Executive Departments and foreign governments. In this position, she oversees and manages an annual operating budget of approximately \$50 million.

Ms. Moomand has over 32 years of extensive leadership experience in accounting, auditing and management. Her accomplishments at the CAD include strategically leading audit effort for the Defense Department's largest programs resulting in billions of dollars in savings. As a Regional Audit Manager, she led the Agency in auditing over \$5.3 billion in war-related contracts. As the Chief of Investigative Support & Operations Audit for Central Region, she was instrumental in several high dollar investigations involving contractor fraud. She led her staff in closing approximately 40 investigative assignments, which resulted in recoveries amounting to over \$30 million and convictions totaling 20 years of Federal imprisonment.

In September 1989, Ms. Moomand began her federal career with DCAA as an auditor at the Dallas Branch Office. In 1994, she transitioned to the Central Regional Office as an Operations Auditor. In 2002, she transitioned to a Supervisory Auditor for the European Branch Office in Wiesbaden, Germany, where she led teams in auditing contractors in over 20 countries throughout Europe and the Middle East. She also served the Agency as a Financial Liaison Advisor at Wright Patterson AFB in Ohio; as a Technical Programs Specialist in the Regional Office researching and providing technical guidance to Central Region Field Audit Offices; as a FAO Manager for the Fort Worth Branch and DynCorp Resident Offices; and then as a Regional Audit Manager from 2008 through 2016. In 2016, she became Regional Special Programs Manager, serving as principal technical advisor and consultant to the newly reorganized Central Regional Offices on critical issues involving complex and controversial audit matters. In November 2019, Ms. Moomand was appointed to the Senior Executive Service as Corporate Audit Director, the position she currently holds.

Ms. Moomand holds a Masters of Policy Management from Georgetown University and a Bachelor of Business Administration in Accounting from the University of Texas at Arlington. She is a Certified Public Accountant in the State of Ohio. Her certifications also include Level III certification in DoD Financial Management and in Defense Acquisition Workforce Improvement Act (DAWIA) – Auditing. In 2011, she was recognized and awarded the DCAA Meritorious Civilian Award, along with a Silver Medal, for consistently demonstrating outstanding leadership and commitment to the Agency and the Department. She has received numerous other awards and recognitions of excellence throughout her distinguished career with the Department of Defense. She and her spouse, Abdul Rahman Moomand, currently reside in Grand Prairie, Texas where she enjoys spending time with her four children and grandchildren.
