JOHN G. MASSENGALE

John G. Massengale serves as the Chief, Data Analytics Division, Director of Staff, Air Force Audit Agency, Pentagon (assigned to Wright-Patterson AFB, OH). In this senior leadership role, he drives the strategic vision and execution of advanced analytics, emerging technologies, and modern data methodologies to transform enterprise audit processes and strengthen Department of the Air Force analytics capabilities. He leads a high-performing team of data professionals dedicated to delivering innovative, scalable solutions that enhance audit readiness, improve operational efficiency, and enable data-informed decision-making at every level. In addition, he oversees data analytics training and upskilling for more than 450 personnel, advancing data literacy and integrating competency frameworks to build the digital and analytical workforce needed for the future mission.

Prior to his current position, Mr. Massengale was a Program Manager in the Acquisition, Logistics, and Financial Audits Directorate, Air Force Audit Agency, Wright-Patterson AFB, OH. He was responsible for the planning, execution, and reporting of Department of the Air Force-wide audits addressing major and non-major weapon system and space acquisitions; research, development, test, and evaluation activities; science and technology programs; small business advocacy and compliance; and contracting functions.



Mr. Massengale began his federal-service career in the Student Temporary Experience Program at the Air Force Research Laboratory (AFRL) in 2004. He then entered the Student Career Experience Program in 2008 and then the Palace Acquire program in 2010 where he served as a base-level auditor with the Air Force Audit Agency at the Wright-Patterson and Robins Area Audit Offices. He has also served as an Audit Manager in the Acquisition and Security and Special Programs divisions; as well as special assignments in the Cyberspace and Maintenance divisions. Lastly, he was a fellow in the Education with Industry (EWI) Program where he served as a Senior Consultant at Guidehouse Inc from 2019-2020.

In addition to his government service, Mr. Massengale co-founded a consumer product start-up, where he served as Vice President and Chief Financial Officer. In this role, he directed business planning, financial strategy, and investor relations while overseeing product development and market expansion. Under his leadership, the company secured venture capital funding and achieved national recognition by winning first place in the University of Dayton's New Venture Creation competition in 2017, prevailing over more than 200 international teams. He concluded his tenure in 2022 to focus on advancing government leadership roles.
