



SCOTT PERRY AIR DIRECTOR



Mr. Perry assumed the position of Air Director in July 2025 where he leads a team of 1,000 personnel providing contract audit and financial advisory services. Mr. Perry oversees an annual operating budget of approximately \$125M, as well as oversight for over 2,000 DoW contractors, including two major contractors, with over \$100B in annual Department spending. Mr. Perry is responsible for the assessments of contractors' business systems and determining the accuracy and acceptability of incurred and proposed contract costs in accordance with GAGAS and FAR for DoW and other Government organizations. Prior to leading the Air Directorate, Mr. Perry served as Regional Director, Western Region, and briefly served as the Assistant Director, Policy, Quality and Legislative Affairs, where he was responsible for developing and issuing agency contract audit policy as well as overseeing all aspects of DCAA's Quality Control System and legislative activities. He entered the Senior Executive Service in 2020, performing the role of the Deputy Regional Director, Western Region.

His DCAA accomplishments include implementation of numerous DCAA initiatives and advancements including the issuance of the first-ever Professional Practice Guide, which provided the framework for implementing specific materiality thresholds for contract auditors. He also was instrumental in establishing DCAA's first-ever program to acquire the services of independent private auditors to conduct incurred cost audits.

Mr. Perry has over 27 years of extensive leadership experience in auditing and financial management. Prior to joining DCAA, he spent 19 years with the U.S. Army Audit Agency, where he held multiple positions, including Program Director for Strategic Initiatives, Communication, and Audit Policy, as well as Program Director for Financial Management Audits and Program Director for Installation Operations Audits.

Mr. Perry holds a Master of Business Administration degree and Master of Arts degree in Public Administration, both from Syracuse University, as well as a Bachelor of Science degree in Accounting from Elizabeth City State University. He is a graduate of the Defense Comptrollership Program; is a Certified Defense Financial Manager and holds a Level-III DoD Financial Management Certification. He has received numerous awards and recognition for outstanding performance throughout his career with the Department, most recently the Leonard F. Keenan Award for Distinguished Service from Syracuse University for his significant contributions to the Defense Resource Management profession.
