Ms. Jennifer Torres was appointed Deputy Air Director, Corporate Audits, Defense Contract Audit Agency (DCAA) in March 2026. Ms. Torres serves as the principal advisor to the Air Director and is responsible for strategic management and operations of the Air Directorate and resources pertaining to major Defense Contractors and their corporate audits. Ms. Torres leads the Corporate Audits organization in execution of the Air Directorate’s mission in providing contract audit, accounting, and financial advisory services to the Department of War, Executive Departments, and foreign governments. She leads the Corporate Audits organization with a focus on aligning audit strategy, operations, and resources to support major defense contractors and oversees approximately \$125 million in annual operating resources.

Ms. Torres brings more than 23 years of federal experience leading complex audits, inspections, and evaluations. She is recognized for her expertise in Government Auditing Standards, internal controls, and risk-based auditing, and for leveraging data analytics, automation, and emerging technologies to enhance audit quality and efficiency. She has a demonstrated history of successfully leading enterprise-wide initiatives, overseeing multimillion-dollar audit portfolios, and aligning audit strategies with National Security objectives and government-wide priorities. Ms. Torres has served in the Department of War and other Federal agencies, consistently showcasing her commitment to protecting taxpayer resources, promoting transparency, and reinforcing accountability across government operations.

Prior to joining DCAA, Ms. Torres served as Deputy Assistant Inspector General for Audit at the Export-Import Bank of the United States Office of Inspector General, where she was responsible for strategic audit planning and advising senior leadership on risk management and internal controls. She also served as Director of Audit Operations and Quality Assurance at the Department of Labor Office of Inspector General, where she led data-driven quality management initiatives, implemented a rotational staffing model, and advanced automated solutions to support professional development and compliance. Earlier in her career, she held leadership roles with the Department of Commerce Office of Audit and Evaluations and the Air Force Audit Agency, conducting complex, high-impact audits supporting global operations. Ms. Torres’ selection as Deputy Air Director marks her first appointment to the Senior Executive Service.

She holds a Bachelor of Business Administration in Accounting from the University of Alaska and Master of Science degrees in Public Administration and Human Resources from Wilmington University. Ms. Torres is a graduate of American University’s Experienced Leader Program and Air University’s Air Command and Staff College, where she further strengthened her executive leadership capabilities and strategic perspective in national security and joint operations. She is a Certified Internal Auditor and a Certified Defense Financial Manager.
